

Horsham Township Library - Code of Conduct

To ensure the comfort and safety of all Library users and staff always behave in a lawful manner and communicate civilly with staff and fellow patrons. Patrons who do not adhere to the below outlined code may be warned by staff or, in necessary instances, the police may be called.

- Respect all patrons and staff: refrain from swearing, disturbing others, and fighting on Library grounds. Always wear clothing appropriate for a public building including shoes at all times.
- Sleeping is not permitted anywhere in the Library.
- Be mindful of children and directly supervise those with you; refrain from running and shouting.
- Maintain clear access to aisles, walkways, and seating.
- Snacks that do not disturb others in noise or aroma are welcome at Library tables that do not have computers.
- No food or drink is permitted at Library owned computers.
- Secure your personal belongings at all times, staff is not responsible for misplaced or stolen items.
- For the safety and comfort of others, bring only service animals into the Library.
- Solicitation is not allowed in the Library or on Library grounds. This includes but is not limited to selling anything such as raffle tickets or candy, begging, panhandling, or circulating petitions.
- Concerning noise level; people or groups talking in louder tones than the general noise level will be asked to lower their voices.
- To contribute to a comfortable noise level please mute the ringer on your cell phone. Keep calls short and quiet and move to the Café/entryway if lasting longer than a few moments. Headphones must be worn on public and personal computers using volume of any level.
