Financial Report

- Hirschberg Mechanical installed the condenser this week, should be completed Friday.
- 2025 included funds for replacement meeting room tables and story room chairs-20 chairs ordered (5 each in 4 different colors, stackable), 6 large tables on wheels to replace the "red" tables, and 2 square wheeled tables to replace the kidney bean tables. All from Demco totaling \$6,959. Budgeted 10,000 for furniture replacements but still need to decide on replacement soft seating in kids area.
- Sending Ellyn, Kyle, and Bryan each to a day of the American Library Association's annual conference being held in Philadelphia this year in June.

Director's Report

Facilities: Hirschberg wrapping up the condenser install this week which is good news for our AC. Tustin will need to add the machinery to our existing controls system and coming out tomorrow to do this.

New furniture expected late April.

Solar project is down township wide. We now have access to the solar dashboard to view out buildings' energy collection vs usage stats.

Programming: Our new Poetry group has taken off-held their second open mic night on Friday and double in speakers. Bryan is bringing in a published poet this summer for a workshop and hosting a writing challenge for April through our beanstack app.

Egg hunt is set for Saturday 4/12 at 10:30am. Friends will be selling concessions and public works will help get the property in shape for it.

Hosting HHSD adult ESL evening classes again this spring, positive partnership. Holding out first Spanish language movie night 4/25 Encanto.

AARP tax sessions once again filled, here every Thursday through tax day.

Summer Reading: Schedule is set working on the promotional materials now. Program will run 6/14-8/8

Friends – Friends book sale 5/1-5/3. Also hosting an author visit in August for Nancy Reddy of "The Good Mother Myth". Friends will work with myself on setting up a local author event likely next winter. Details to come.

MCLINC Updates: First round interviews for the new Director of Operations were in February with 9 applicants out of 200+. Second round in person interviews were completed between this week and last with the final 3. Hope to make an offer in the next 2 weeks. Our system is also getting an upgrade on 4/9 which may result in some offline time in the morning.
